- Communication: Thank you notes were written by Mrs. Annette Kappelman's 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade class for paying the difference for the AR and STAR Program and for the bus to Ag day and Lyceum theatre. They also had one for the UCM Literature Festival.

Treasurers Report: Ending balance of \$18,551.47. A washer and dryer were purchased for the school. There are a couple of outstanding checks. Cara approved. Jennifer second.

Old Business:

- AR: Reported by Annette Kappelman. The total cost was approximately \$5,313.00. \$5,000 was donated by an anonymous person. PTL paid for the rest. An annual fee of approximately \$2,400 is expected. Hopefully the funds will be raised through grants and fundraisers.
- Washer/Dryer: Reported by Kali. PTL purchased a washer and dryer for the school. Gash's plumbing did the plumbing work and installed it. Tim Frerking took care of the wiring. This was a great building improvement.
- Christian Concert: Reported by Kali. This was a success. The band members had fun and would do it again. It was suggested to possibly incorporate them into the PTL auction for 2018. Jessica Johnson also added that her husband Chris's brother would also be interested in performing. The concession stand supplies were donated by a generous person. It brought in \$72.50. The money from the performance was donated to the school for IT. The band members were given a donation for their performance. One of them donated their check back.
- Craft Fair: Sarah was unable to attend. We are still in need of some vendors.
- Field Trips: Reported by the teachers. 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades went to Jefferson City. The School Day at the K is coming up for grades K-8. More information will be coming out in the Cat Pause and through text. T-shirts for the day have been ordered. Preschool visited Mrs. Pam's house. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade went to Meyer Care Center and to Hemme Brothers Cheese Farm.
- Spring Musical: The stage is being worked on. Audrey is the student director. The kids are working on the songs. The music was donated.

- Desert Bar: This is the same night as the musical. Cara needs volunteers to help and to donate desserts. Melissa is working on the special gifts/decorations for the teachers.
- Bookfair: Miss. Onnen needs more volunteers to help with shifts for the book fair. They are squeezing it all in the Art Room. It will be held Friday, April 28<sup>th</sup>-Friday, May 5<sup>th</sup>.
- Labels: Mr. Millie signed the school up to start collecting Tyson food labels.

#### New Business:

- Beautification: Kali explained to the new staff members about the PTL collecting summer wish lists from teachers and organizing workdays to help make the school look good for the fall.
  - Miss. Onnen reported that the downstairs bathroom floor paint chips off. Gail the custodian has said that the color is not easy to see to be able to get cleaned. A more neutral color would be better. The boys bathroom urinal is a magnet for the pea gravel from the playground. The drain becomes clogged often. The plumbing is not in good condition.
  - Mrs. Kappelman would like to have a closet for her room. It could even be a portable cabinet. This would be a buffer for the Principal's office. Sound travels through.
  - Beth Edwards is going to send Cara an example of a form that they use at her work to help with the wish list and to keep it organized.
  - A date for a summer work day will be set after all teachers can send in their requests and we find out Gail's cleaning schedule. Cara will send out an e-mail to staff.
- Track and Field Day: Reported by Cara. The field day is scheduled for May 18<sup>th</sup>. She needs some new game ideas. Maybe some teachers would like to have science experiments in the park. Beth Edwards would get some games to Cara. The 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade girls could possibly help with an obstacle course.
