Opening: prayer lead by Stephanie

Minutes: read by Jennifer. Cara motioned to accept them as read. Mr. Frank second.

Treasurer's Report and Budget: Cara reported the balance is \$17,961.32 and read over some of the items on the account. Kali motioned to approve the budget. Jennifer second.

Old Business:

- **Auction:** Update given by Ashlynn and Katie. Golden tickets will be sent home with the kids. New this year, people can fill out ticket and choose to be invoiced instead of waiting in line at the end of the night. Credit cards can be accepted, but may be a slow process. Moose's Market will be **catering** for \$9 per person. Includes 2 meats, cheesy potatoes, salad, vegetable, rolls, dessert and table wear. LaBella Winery gave a discount on wine. Brunswick Distributing donating some drinks. We have \$250 from Thrivent to use toward auction. **Childcare** was discussed. Cynthia had an idea to see if the high school kids could help out. Ashlynn will ask Courtney Bergsieker the FACS teacher at the high school if some of her students would be willing to help. Asking for free will donations for childcare. Teresa and Susan would possibly be the staff members to volunteer to help with childcare. This will be for school age children that are potty trained ages 3 and up. Any auction attendee can send kids, not just for members or enrolled students. Possibly the LYF group could help too. For the **dinner**, helpers pay for tickets and staff plus one guest are in free. High school helpers are free. **Wear** Thrivent shirts the night of the auction if helping out. We need more volunteers to fill out **Thrivent forms** to earn more Thrivent funds. Cara has a contact that can help guide this process. Beth will help coordinate this. **Decorations:** Sarah Cook is getting with Kerri Borchers for red carpet and ropes. For centerpieces, going to make similar ones like what Glenda Rieckhoff has. Colors will be gold, black and red. Using stars and film items for stage and tables. Ask Terri Ray if she has any items to use. Putting scriptures on a director's cut was a suggestion. Kali suggested putting out a board stating where the funds go to. Beth said to use photos from the trips that we provided the funds for. **Sound System:** Ashlynn talked to Joe Rolf and he will do this free of charge. **Donations:** These need to be in by Friday, January 26th for pictures and advertisement. Many are coming in through the mail. Teachers are working on class items. Ashlynn will keep us up to date about set up. She passed around a signup sheet for helpers.
- **Basketball Update:** There is a one on one tournament coming up.

New Business:

- **Lutheran Schools Week:** January 21-27. An online mission trip to Cambodia is planned.
- **Soup and Chili Dinner:** At Zion Lutheran on January 28. Still need some volunteers to bring chili and vegetables.
- **School Dance:** February 16. This is a fundraiser for the 7/8th grade class trip. They are renting lighting. There will be a lasagna dinner. A photo booth will be there.
- **Spring Musical/Teacher Appreciation/Dessert Bar:** This is May 2nd. Cara will need donations for desserts and helpers to serve. Need someone to help with decorations. Possibly Melissa Linebach.
- **Track and Field Day:** Scheduled for May 15th. Natalie volunteered to chair this event this year. Cara will pass down supplies to her.
- **Book Fair:** Katie is looking at having this with the spring musical.
- **Building Improvements:** A dishwasher is needed in the kitchen for sanitation reasons. Some rooms need paint. There was a suggestion to have these as an auction item for someone to donate money toward. This will need to be looked into further to know exactly the cost.
- **Teacher/Principal Comments:** The school now has secure wifi! There are 10 two in one tablet/laptops for students to use. There was a \$15,000 anonymous donation. Teacher computers, wifi, smart boards, and 2 way radios were purchased.
- **Postcards:** Use these to hand out to promote the school.
